What is this?

This is a ready-made AI prompt. A set of instructions you copy and paste into any AI chatbot. Once you paste it in, the AI will ask you a series of questions about your family, your space and your eggs. Answer them honestly and it will create a personalised Easter egg hunt plan just for you.

No tech skills needed. No extra account required beyond the AI tool you choose to use. Just copy, paste, answer a few questions and let the AI do the heavy lifting while you find the chocolate stash.

Which AI tool can I use?

This prompt works with any AI chatbot, free or paid. You do not need to upgrade to a paid plan. Here are some popular options:

- ChatGPT (chatgpt.com) – Free plan available. Great for families new to AI.
- Claude (claude.ai) – Free plan available. Excellent for creative, detailed output.
- Google Gemini (gemini.google.com) – Free plan available. Great if you already use Google.
- Microsoft Copilot (copilot.microsoft.com) – Free. Works well on Windows and in Microsoft Edge.
- Meta AI (meta.ai) – Free. Available directly inside Instagram, WhatsApp and Facebook.

Already have a favourite. Use that one. They all work with this prompt.

How to use this prompt

Step 1	Open your AI tool of choice and start a new conversation.
Step 2	Scroll to the prompt section below. Select all the text from the dashed line to the end. Copy it.
Step 3	Paste the prompt into the AI chat and press send. Then answer its questions and let it do the work!

How long will this take?

Task	Time
Answering the questions	5 to 10 minutes
AI creates your hunt plan	Under 60 seconds
Total	Under 15 minutes

The most time consuming part is answering the questions. The more detail you give the AI, the better the plan it creates. If it gets something wrong, just tell it and ask it to try again, it is good at taking direction.

A note on AI transparency

This prompt was created by Tracy Sheen, AI educator and author, using AI assistance. That is exactly what Human-led. AI-leveraged. looks like in practice. A human with a clear goal, working with AI to do the heavy lifting.

The Easter egg hunt plan the AI creates for you is AI-generated content. Give it a read before you use it. Tweak anything that does not suit your family, your space or your vibe. You are always in charge.

No personal details you share with the AI are seen or stored by Tracy Sheen or Juice 107.3. You are interacting directly with whichever AI tool you choose. Check the privacy policy of your chosen platform if you have questions about how your data is handled.

Step 2 – The Space

- Will the hunt be indoors, outdoors, or a mix of both?
- Can you describe the area where the hunt will take place? For example: a backyard with garden beds and a trampoline, an apartment lounge and hallway, a community park.
- If your AI tool supports image uploads, you are also welcome to share a photo of the space – the more detail, the better the hiding spots.
- Do you have a wet-weather backup plan, or would you like me to suggest an indoor alternative just in case?

Step 3 – The Eggs

- How many Easter eggs or treats will be hidden?
- Do you have a photo of the eggs, or can you describe them? Size matters for hiding spots!

Ask: What would you like me to create for you?

- A step-by-step organiser guide for the grown-up running the show

Before you create anything

Summarise everything back to the person in a friendly, easy-to-read list. Ask: "Here is what I have got – does this all look right before I get started?" Only begin creating the Easter egg hunt plan once they confirm.

When you deliver the final plan

- Make it warm, joyful and easy to follow
- Use simple language – stressed parents do not need complicated
- Include a short encouraging note celebrating the joy of Easter and the gift of time with family
